No. The information available to date indicates that less than 20% of the restaurants have potentially been affected. The following is a list of those restaurants that were potentially affected. We will update this list if necessary.

2. **What personal information may have been accessed?**

Name and credit and debit card information.

3. When did this apparent breach happen?

Upon learning of the possibility of unauthorized access, we hired and worked with experts in data breach investigations who are still in the process of examining data, but have now found indications that unauthorized access did occur at some of the restaurants and that such access likely commenced at the beginning of March. In addition, upon learning of the possibility of unauthorized access to credit and debit card information, ALL of the individual owners of the Penn Station restaurants changed the method for processing credit and debit card transactions. Based on the actions taken when Penn Station owners first learned of the possibility of unauthorized access, if you visited one of the above Penn Station restaurants during the time period from the beginning of March to the end of April and used a credit or debit card to pay for your purchase, you should be alert for the possibility of fraudulent charges on your credit or debit card.

4. What are you doing so it doesn't happen again?

Upon learning of a possibility of unauthorized access at some of the restaurants, the owners of the restaurants took prompt steps to implement changes to the method for processing credit and debit cards at each restaurant to stop the possible unauthorized access. These changes were made at ALL Penn Station restaurants, and included restaurants even where there was no evidence of possible unauthorized access.

5. Will I receive any additional information or updates?

As indicated above, if we learn of more restaurants that were affected, we will update the list noted above.

6. If I have additional questions, who can I contact at Penn Station?

7. Is there anything I can do?

If you do find suspicious activity on your credit or debit card or in your credit report, call the bank that issued your card to report the unauthorized charges immediately.
